

**Four Northern California Adventist Hospitals
Name Medical Director for Northern California Cardiovascular Initiative**

Brian J. Mundy, M.D., interventional cardiologist, has been named Medical Director for the coordination of cardiovascular services between the four Adventist Health hospitals operating in Northern California.

Mundy will be joining the medical staffs of Ukiah Valley Medical Center and Frank R. Howard Memorial Hospital in Mendocino County, St. Helena Hospital in the Napa Valley and Redbud Hospital in Lake County. Mundy will work collaboratively with operational, clinical and physician leadership at all four hospitals.

Mundy obtained his medical training from the University of Washington School of Medicine in Seattle. He completed a residency in Internal Medicine at Providence St. Vincent Medical Center in Portland, Oregon, and a three-year Cardiovascular Fellowship at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit, Michigan.

He recently completed an Interventional Cardiology Fellowship at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis, where he was associated with The Care Group, a 44-member cardiology physician group. Mundy is also affiliated with the Cardiovascular Radiology and Intervention Council of the American Heart Association

He is board eligible in Interventional Cardiology and has specialized training in cardiac and peripheral vascular procedures.

"We are pleased to have the leadership of Doctor Mundy as the hospitals in Clearlake, Ukiah and Willits work with The Cardiovascular Center at St. Helena Hospital to build a network of heart and vascular services." says Alan Rice, senior vice president at Adventist Health in Roseville and chair of the governing boards at all four hospitals.
